

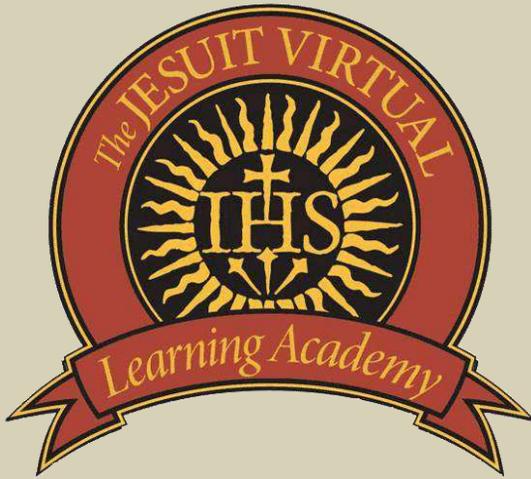

### ITC Badges



This facilitated course focuses on specific strategies for how to manage the one to one classroom. We will explore how to start and end class when in a one-to-one environment. We will discuss how to handle off task and distracting behaviors with students on devices. And we will learn about how the physical classroom arrangement and effective teacher monitoring can keep students engaged in a one-to-one classroom. This course will culminate in creating a functional and goal-oriented classroom management plan teachers can use in their one-to-one classrooms regularly. [Register](#)

We all know how wonderful the classroom is when we hit on the right mix of learning strategies. We also know how difficult it is to consistently find that balance. For most students, engagement increases in line with the degree to which they are challenged to process material in new and different ways. However, this can be difficult to achieve, particularly considering the content demands imposed by a standards-driven system. This course explores strategies for igniting and sustaining creativity in your lessons, in yourself and in your students. By the end of the course participants should leave with at least one ready to use lesson that incorporates the creative strategies they have learned. [Register](#)

## Cyberbullying & Online Safety

We will learn about a few of the latest social media tools and apps that students are using and how to ensure our students stay safe in online environments. We will learn how to identify student behaviors in order to intervene when a student is being bullied and discuss best practices for issuing consequences to those who violate our school's online acceptable use policies. During this course, you will learn a few best teaching practices for how to group students, manage and assess student group work, and how to set and implement clear goals and deadlines for group projects and activities. You will learn how to use a variety of technology tools to help facilitate group work, collaboration, assessment and feedback. By the end of this course participants will have developed at least one engaging lesson plan and effective assessment focused on group work and collaboration. [Register](#)

Participants will practice writing measurable objectives using the S.M.A.R.T strategy and Bloom's Taxonomy. We will incorporate elements of Backwards Design unit and lesson planning to create standards based assessments that measure student's knowledge and skills. Teachers in all content areas are welcome to join us and by the end of the four weeks, each participant will have created at least one formative and one summative assessment to incorporate into their classrooms.

### WHAT TO EXPECT FROM YOUR COURSE

This is an online course designed for teachers who want to be in community as they learn. Participants will be expected to participate in synchronous and asynchronous activities including:

- Complete and respond to online readings/texts
- Watch and respond to instructional videos/tutorials
- Actively participate in online discussions
- Create sample lesson plans, assessments and classroom activities
- Give and receive constructive feedback to peers and colleagues
- Participate in weekly synchronous video meetings/webinars\*
- Submit assignments in a timely manner

## ABOUT CONTINUING EDUCATION UNITS (CEUs)

### ***What are CEUs?***

A **continuing education unit (CEU)** or **continuing education credit (CEC)** is a measure used in continuing education programs to assist the professional to maintain his or her license in their profession.

### ***Who awards the CEUs?***

The JVLA has a partnership with Regis University to award course participants CEUs.

### ***Are CEUs the same as college credit?***

No. They are awarded by Regis University but they are professional development credits NOT college credit and you will not receive a transcript.

### ***What is the cost of CEUs? Why is there a separate charge?***

There is a flat fee of \$25 for the awarding of CEUs. This covers all administrative costs of processing and mailing certificates. There are two reasons we charge separately for CEUs: 1) some participants do not need CEUs, and 2) CEUs can only be earned upon successful completion of course requirements. Charging separately enables course moderators/instructors to verify completion.

### ***What if I don't want to earn CEUs?***

Simply do not submit the CEU request form.

### ***If I don't get a transcript how will I know I've received credit?***

After you successfully complete a course and submit a CEU Request Form, the request will be sent to Regis for processing at the end of the semester in which you took the course. Regis can take anywhere from 2-4 weeks to process the request and a certificate will be mailed to your school/institution.

### ***How do you calculate how many CEUs I can earn per course?***

You can earn CEUs for any Experience level courses you take with the JVLA. Each type of course has a set number of CEUs that participants can earn based on the average number of hours spent on course activities.

10 hrs = 1 CEU

Experience Courses = 5 hrs a week of work

3 Week Courses: 1.5 CEUs

4 Week Courses: 2 CEUs

6 Week Courses: 3 CEUs

# IGNATIAN TEACHING CERTIFICATE BADGE DESCRIPTORS

*The goal of the [Ignatian Teaching Certificate \(ITC\)](#) program is to provide teachers practical experiences that lead to the thoughtful incorporation of online/blended approaches into their classrooms. The ITC is awarded to participants who have earned all 11 Experience Badges in the following categories.*

## **Online Instructional Approaches**

The online teacher knows the primary concepts and structures of effective online instruction and is able to create learning experiences to enable student success.

## **Technology Tools**

The online teacher understands and is able to use a range of technologies, both existing and emerging, that effectively support student learning and engagement in the online environment.

## **Learning Strategies**

The online teacher plans, designs, and incorporates strategies to encourage active learning, application, interaction, participation, and collaboration in the online environment.

## **Digital Citizenship**

The online teacher models, guides, and encourages legal, ethical, and safe behavior related to technology use.

## **Differentiation**

The online teacher is cognizant of the diversity of student academic needs and incorporates accommodations into the online environment.

## **Creating Assessments**

The online teacher demonstrates competencies in creating and implementing assessments in online learning environments in ways that ensure validity and reliability of the instruments and procedures.

## **Assessing Learning Progress**

The online teacher develops and delivers assessments, projects, and assignments that meet standards-based learning goals and assesses learning progress by measuring student achievement of the learning goals.

## **Assessment Data**

The online teacher demonstrates competency in using data from assessments and other data sources to modify content and to guide student learning.

## **External Communications**

The online teacher interacts in a professional, effective manner with colleagues, parents, and other members of the community to support students' success.

## **Internal Communications**

The online teacher promotes student success through clear expectations, prompt responses, and regular feedback.

## **Instructional Design (Portfolio Review)**

The online teacher arranges media and content to help students and teachers transfer knowledge most effectively in the online environment.
